Zach Oleksiuk, CFA, is Head of BlackRock's Americas Corporate Governance and Responsible Investment team. The team is responsible for analyzing and voting proxies for issuers in the Americas; engaging with directors, executives and other market participants on corporate governance issues; developing BlackRock's corporate governance policies; and supporting BlackRock's global proxy voting operations. The team also actively works with BlackRock's portfolio companies to address economic risks that arise from social, environmental and ethical issues, and coordinates the integration of corporate governance and responsible investment considerations into the investment process.

Mr. Oleksiuk's service with the firm dates back to 2006, including his years with Barclays Global Investors (BGI), which merged with BlackRock in 2009. Prior to joining BGI, he spent five years at Institutional Shareholder Services (ISS) where he managed proxy voting solutions for investment managers and custodian banks.

Mr. Oleksiuk earned an MBA from the Smith School of Business at the University of Maryland and a BA from the Pennsylvania State University. He is a CFA charterholder and is a member of the New York Society of Security Analysts (NYSSA), where he chairs the Corporate Governance committee and sits on the Sustainable Investing committee.
